

A Sure Word!

2Pe 1:19 We have also a **more sure word of prophecy**; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts:

2Pe 1:20 Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the Scripture is of any private interpretation.

2Pe 1:21 For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were **moved by the Holy Ghost**. (it is the same today)

The Holy Ghost wants to talk to you! He has your number can you not hear the phone ringing?????

He wants to tell you what Jesus has said, He wants to tell you things to come, He wants to comfort, lead, guide, instruct, correct as He points you to the Father through Jesus the Son. **WE NEED THE HOLY SPIRIT NOW!**

Joh 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

Joh 10:5 And a stranger will they not follow, but will flee from him: for they know not the voice of strangers.

TWO KEYS – SAY WHAT God SAYS, DO WHAT God DOES -

Joh 12:50 And I know that his commandment is life everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto me, so I speak. **(Jesus said what the Father said)**

Joh 5:19 Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise. **(Jesus did what the Father did)**

God did not call us to be an apathetic, pathetic person – but people who live in Word and Power!

Joh 4:24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

Examples: Eph. 1:17-19 and Eph. 3:17-19

Prophecy is something that everyone can do. Prophecy is simply **speaking forth** what God has said.

Everyone can hear what God is saying. This is not the office of the Prophet in Eph 4:11

The greatest prophecy that exists is the Bible.

Rev 19:10**the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.**

- The testimony of Jesus is who He is, what He has done. The good news, the gospel
- The greatest voice you have is your own – speaking forth what God has said to you.
- Also speaking forth what God has said about you, for you, in you, through you, (get the picture) **Speaking the Word**

Too many bring - Another Jesus

Many people (any people) will try and give you another God, one they think is better than the one you have. –

2Co 11:4 For if he that cometh **preacheth another Jesus**, whom we have not preached, or if ye **receive another spirit**, which ye have not received, **or another gospel**, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him. (keep the perfect God you have)

Gal 1:6 I marvel that ye **are so soon removed** from him that called you into the grace of Christ **unto another gospel**:

What is another Jesus – one who does not do what the Bible says, one who does not heal, deliver, set free, make glad, give peace, joy, purpose etc. – this would be another Jesus **(you might say another WORD)**

Also one who changes the way and method in which we get saved and get back to the Father.

Why would you want or entertain another God?

Don't try and give me a new God, the one I have is perfect. You cannot improve on Jesus !!!!

We must have a steadfast, sure , final position on who God is and what we say about Him.

He is not a watered down, polluted, user friendly God that is weak being a mixture of Christianity, new age and humanism – He is true, pure, sure and forever – uncompromising. He is FINAL!

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- **Two problems – 1. What do we believe and 2. Do we really believe what we believe!!!!**
- **Believing enough to speak it forth**

Rom 4:16 Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by grace; to the end **the promise might be sure to all the seed**; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all,

What is it to be sure? WHAT IS A SURE WORD???

By definition – Sure means: 1) stable, fast, firm, trusty, stable, steadfast - admitting of no doubt, without doubt or question : CERTAINLY –
with no wavering, not even in thought (double-minded)

Certain,
Permanent,
absolute

Psa 111:7-10 The works of his hands are verity (true and real) and judgment; **all his commandments are sure**. 8 They **stand fast forever and ever**, and are done in truth and uprightness. 9 He sent redemption unto his people: he hath commanded his covenant forever: holy and reverend is his name. 10 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: a good verity understanding have all they that do his commandments: his praise endureth forever.

Sureness speaks of purity – (no compromise, no mixture, no pollution)

Joh 14:30 Hereafter I will not talk much with you: for the prince of this world cometh, **and hath nothing in me**.

- This position we need – We must keep our eye on **not allowing** anything that is not God into our **belief system** and especially into our **prophecy system** (our speaking, declaring, decreeing etc.).

Many of the false and subtle infiltrations into the body of Christ are based in eastern religions, new age, humanism, cultic and occultic beliefs. Also working is a strong religious spirit, man trying to be good enough to be saved.

God's WORD IS ABSOLUTE, FINAL, FOREVER, IT NEVER CHANGES, OUR ISSUES DO NOT ALTER THE WORD.

Mal 3:6 For I am the LORD, I change not;

Psa 119:89 Forever, O LORD, thy word is settled in heaven.

2Co 1:20 For **all the promises** of God in him are **yea**, and in him **Amen**, unto the glory of God by us.

2Pe 1:3 According as his divine power **hath given unto us all things** that pertain unto **life** and

godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:

2Pe 1:4 Whereby are **given unto us exceeding great and precious promises**: that by these ye

might **be partakers** of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

Heb 7:22 By so much was Jesus made a **surety** of a better testament. (Better covenant)

SURETY – like a bondsman, the guarantee that which is made sure, will happen, come about etc.

Failure to believe – have real Bible faith, God kind of faith.

- Do we just believe that the Bible is true and what is in it is true, that is not faith.

Mar 11:22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. (original says – have the God kind of faith)

- True Bible, God kind of faith simply takes what God said, says it, receives it and lives in the truth 24/7.

If God said it, then it is true, it shall come to pass and the promise to me are mine and I have it NOW!

I am not moved by what I see, hear or are told but I am moved by the Word of God and what God has said.

What is it that God cannot do today, that He did in the book of Acts?

Another way to clarify this is "CIRCUMSTANCES" do not rule and reign my life or in my life.

Yes we have to deal with natural situations, but they should not be the ruling force in our lives.

When all hell breaks loose, talk about heaven – When sickness comes talk about healing, when fear comes talk about boldness and confidence, when depression comes, talk about joy and peace. When bills come in talk about prosperity.

- Doing God faith clarifies and magnifies the simplicity of the truth of the word and our ease of believing it.
- One thing is sure and true, you will always know where you stand with God.
- He never changes His mind, His position, His Word, His plan, His purpose, or His end result.

The only decisive action that will alter the promises of God is YOU AND ME.

Three final questions to ponder ----

What do you believe today?

What are you saying about your challenges?

What are you saying your God can do about them?

God gave us a "SURE WORD" it is our job to live in that Word !
