

## Disorderly Conduct

2Th 3:6 Now we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye withdraw yourselves from every brother that walketh **disorderly**, and not after the tradition which he received of us.

**Disorderly:** out of rank, inordinate pleasures, deviation from prescribed order or rule, lawless, lifestyle of disorder, offensive conduct (Paul said, let everything be done, decently and in order. To be in DISORDER is to be out of the order of God that He has put in place for your life. We must understand that many times God's order may look like chaos, but God is a God of order and does everything accordingly.

2Th 3:7 For yourselves know how ye ought to follow us: for we behaved not ourselves **disorderly** among you;

2Th 3:11 For we hear that there are some which walk among you **disorderly**, working not at all, but are busybodies.

2Th 3:14 And if any man **obey not our word** by this epistle, note that man, and have no company with him, that he may be ashamed. 15 Yet count *him* not as an enemy, but admonish *him* as a brother.

Rom 16:17 Now I beseech you, brethren, **mark them which cause divisions and offenses** contrary to the doctrine which ye have learned; and **avoid them**.

Rom 13:1 Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God. 2 Whosoever therefore resisteth the power, resisteth the **ordinance** (the set order) of God: and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation.

**Unruly:** cannot be restrained - (no rules –the word lasciviousness comes to mind (no restraints)

1Th 5:14 Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are **unruly**, comfort the feebleminded, support the weak, be patient toward all *men*.

Tit 1:6 If any be blameless, the husband of one wife, having faithful children not accused of riot or **unruly**.

Tit 1:10 For there are many **unruly** and vain talkers and deceivers, especially they of the circumcision:

Jas 3:8 But the tongue can no man tame; *it is* an unruly evil, full of deadly poison.

**Dis:** do the opposite of – disorder, disease, disobey etc.

Scripture relates the greatest form of disorder that God talks about is “causing **discord** or **division** in

the body” – Doing so in or with words, actions or our lifestyle. God hates division and discord among 7 things, He calls abominations! (Disgusting to God) detestable!

- We are warned not to cause anyone to stumble.
- We are warned not to cause strife or division about the word of God.
- We are warned not to associate with evil, to even shun the appearance of such, not to even talk of it.
- We are warned not to take counsel from the ungodly or walk in their ways.
- We are commanded not to fellowship with unbelief, unrighteousness, darkness, anything of the devil, non-believers, idols
- We are commanded to give the devil no place, room, access etc to our lives.

### Not to Blame, Shame, but to AIM!

**Correction allowed** – to make an adjustment to the course heading so as not to miss the desired destination

We are Fully Equipped – Given all things pertaining to life and godliness we can do all things through Christ.

We are Fully Anointed – The anointing abides within us – 1 John 2:27

We are Fully Called - Rom 1:6,7 – appointed, invited (specifically, a saint)

- Rom 5:5 And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is **given unto us**.
- 2Co 5:5 Now he that hath wrought us for the selfsame thing *is* God, who also hath **given unto us** the earnest of the Spirit.
- Eph 4:7 But unto every one of us **is given** grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ.
- 1Th 4:8 He therefore that despiseth, despiseth not man, but God, who hath also **given unto us** his Holy Spirit.
- 2Pe 1:3 According as his divine power hath **given unto us** all things that *pertain* unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:
- 2Pe 1:4 Whereby are **given unto us** exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

**but to AIM!**

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- Activate** – the root word of course is “ACTIVE” – to make or become active
- Instruct** – root word “STRUCTURE” - to teach, train, direct, to build,
- Motivate** – root word “MOTIVE” – the desire which causes action or movement
- Momentum – grab every moment in God so that the force of God in your life is strong and cannot be stopped.

Divine interruption – The short-circuiting of the devils plan and violation of our lives.

Demonic interruption – the short-circuiting of God's plan for our live, our anointing, our blessing, our joy.

Veil of the flesh – The devil works with our flesh, our mind and tempts us to make wrong decisions.

They are called “Spiritual Disciplines” – These are things that we must have on-going in our lives in fullness.

1. Meditation/Bible reading
2. Prayer
3. Fasting
4. Warfare
5. Praise/Worship of God
6. Work – not being lazy
7. Rest
8. Giving – every kind

Our weaknesses in any of these areas indicate “passivity” in our lives.

**Passivity:** not active or operating, inactive, no movement

Our weakness in any of these disciplines will give the devil an “entrance” into our lives to bring torment, oppression, depression, hopelessness and all the other ugly stuff he deals in.

**ACTIVATED, INSTRUCTED, MOTIVATED**
