

Healing Scriptures (Amplified Bible)

Ex. 15:26

Saying, If you will diligently hearken to the voice of the Lord your God, and will do what is right in His sight, and will listen to and obey His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases upon you which I brought upon the Egyptians; for I am the Lord Who heals you.

Ex. 23:25

You shall serve the Lord your God; He shall bless you bread and water, and I will take sickness from your midst.

Deut. 7:15

And the Lord will take away from you all sickness, and none of the evil diseases of Egypt, which you knew, will He put upon you, but will lay them upon all who hate you.

Deut. 30:19,20

I Call Heaven and earth to witness this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, the blessing and the curse; therefore choose life, that you and your descendants may live; To love the Lord you God, to obey His voice, and to cling to Him; for He is your life, and the length of your days, that you may dwell in the land which the Lord swore to give to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

I Kings 8:56

Blessed be the Lord Who has given rest to His people Israel, according to all that He promised, Not one word has failed of all His good promise which He promised through Moses His servant.

Psa. 91:9,10

Because you have made the Lord your refuge, and the Most High your dwelling place, There shall no evil befall you, nor any plague or calamity come near your tent.

Psa. 91:14-16

Because he has set his love upon Me, therefore will I deliver him; I will set him on high, because he knows and understands My name (has a personal knowledge of My mercy, love and kindness; trusts and relies on Me, knowing I will never forsake him, no, never). He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him; With long life will I satisfy him, and show him My salvation.

Psa. 103:1-5

Bless affectionately, gratefully praise the Lord, O my soul, and all that is (deepest) within me, bless His holy name! Bless affectionately, gratefully praise the Lord, O my soul, and forget not (one of) all His benefits, Who forgives (every one of) all your iniquities, Who heals (each of) all your diseases; Who redeems your life from the pit and corruption; Who beautifies, dignifies and crowns you with loving-kindness and tender mercies; Who satisfies your mouth (your necessity and desire at your personal age) with good; so that your youth, renewed, is like the eagle's (strong, overcoming, soaring)!

Psa 107:19-21

Then they cry to the Lord in their trouble, and He delivers them out of their distresses. He sends forth His word and heals them and rescues them from the pit and destruction. Oh, that men would praise (and confess to) the Lord His goodness and loving-kindness, and His wonderful works to the children of men!

Pro. 4:20-23

My son, attend to my words; consent and submit to my sayings. Let them not depart from your sight; keep them in the center of your heart. For they are life to those who find them, healing and health to all their flesh. Keep your heart with all vigilance and above all that you guard, for out of it flow the springs of life.

Isa. 41:10

Fear not; (there is nothing to fear) for I am with you; do not look around you in terror and be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen and harden you (to difficulties); yes, I will help you; yes, I will hold you up and retain with My victorious right hand of rightness and justice.

Isa. 53:4-5

Surely He has borne our griefs, sickness, weakness and distress and carried our sorrows and pain (of punishment). Yet we ignorantly considered Him stricken, smitten and afflicted by God (as if with leprosy). But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our guilt and iniquities; the chastisement needful to obtain peace and well-being for us was upon Him, and with the stripes that wounded Him we are healed and made whole.

Healing Scriptures (Amplified Bible)

Jer. 1:12

Then said the Lord to me, You have seen well, for I am alert and active, watching over My word to perform it.

Jer 30:17

For I will restore health to you, and I will heal your wounds, says the Lord; because they have called you an outcast, saying, This is Zion, whom no one seeks after and for whom no one cares!

Joel 3:10

Beat your plowshares into swords, and your pruning hooks into spears; let the weak say, I am strong, a warrior!

Nahum 1:9

What do you devise and (how mad is your attempt to) plot against the Lord? He will make a full end of Nineveh; affliction (which My people shall suffer from Assyria) shall not rise up the second time.

Matt 8:2-3

And behold, a leper came up to Him and prostrating himself, worshipped Him, saying, Lord, if You will, You are able to cleanse me by curing me. And He reached out His hand and touched him, saying, I will; be cleansed by being cured, And instantly his leprosy was cured and cleansed.

Matt. 8:7

And Jesus said to him, I will come and restore him.

Matt 8:16-18

When evening came they brought to Him many who were under the power of demons, and He drove out the spirits with a word, and restored to health all who were sick; And thus He fulfilled what was spoken by the prophet Isaiah, He Himself took (in order to carry away) our weaknesses and infirmities and bore away our diseases.

Matt. 18:18-19

Truly, I tell you, whatever you forbid and declare to be improper and unlawful on earth must be what is already forbidden in heaven, and whatever you permit and declare proper and lawful on earth must be already permitted in heaven. Again I tell you, if two of you on earth agree (harmonize together, together make a symphony) about - anything and everything - whatever

they shall ask, it will come to pass and be done for them by My Father in heaven.

Mark 11:22-25

And Jesus replying said to them, Have faith in God (constantly). Truly, I tell you, whoever says to this mountain, Be lifted up and thrown into the sea! and does not doubt at all in his heart, but believes that what he says will take place, it will be done for him. for this reason I am telling you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe - trust and be confident - that it is granted to you, and you will (get it). And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him and let it drop - leave it, let it go - in order that your Father Who is in heaven may also forgive you your (own) failing and shortcomings and let them drop.

Mark 16:14-18

Afterward He appeared to the eleven (apostles, themselves) as they reclined at table; and He reproved and reproached them for their unbelief (their lack of faith) and their hardness of heart, because they had refuse to believe those who had seen Him and looked at Him attentively after He was risen (from death). And He said to them, Go into all the world and preach and publish openly the good news (the Gospel) to every creature (of the whole human race). He who believes - (that is,) who adheres to and trusts in and relies on the gospel and Him Whom it sets forth - and is baptized will be saved (from the penalty of eternal death); but he who does not believe - who does not adhere to and trust in and rely on the Gospel and Him whom it sets forth - will be condemned. And these attesting signs will accompany those who believe: in My name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new languages; They will pick up serpents, and (even) if they drink anything deadly, it will not hurt them; they will lay their hands on the sick, and they will get well.

Rom. 4:16-21

Therefore (inheriting) the promise is the outcome of faith and depends (entirely) on faith, in order that it might be given as an act of grace (unmerited favor), to make it stable and valid and guaranteed to all his descendants; not only to the devotees and adherents of the Law but also to those who share the faith of Abraham, who is (this) the father of us all, As it is written, I have made you the father of many nations. - He was appointed our father - in the sight of God in Whom he believed, Who

gives life to the dead and speaks of the non-existent things that (He has foretold and promised) as if they (already) existed. (For Abraham, human reason for) hope being gone,

hoped on in faith that he should become the father of many nations, as he had been promised, So (numberless) shall your descendants be. He did not weaken in faith when he considered the (utter) impotence of his own body, which was as good as dead because he was about a hundred years old, or (when he considered) the barrenness of Sarah's (deadened) womb. No unbelief or distrust made him waver or doubtfully question concerning the promise of God, but he grew strong and was empowered by faith as he gave praise and glory to God, fully satisfied and assured that God was able and mightily to keep His word and to do what He had promised.

Rom. 8:2

For the law of the Spirit of life (which is) in Christ Jesus (the law of our new being), has freed me from the law of sin and of death.

Rom. 8:11

And if the Spirit of Him Who raised up Jesus from the dead dwells in you, (then) He Who raised up Christ Jesus from the dead will also restore to life your mortal (short-lived, perishable) bodies through His Spirit Who dwells in you.

II Cor. 10:3-5

For though we walk (live) in the flesh, we are not carrying on our warfare according to the flesh and using mere human weapons. For the weapons of our warfare are not physical (weapons of flesh and blood), but they are mighty before God for the overthrow and destruction of strongholds, (Inasmuch as we) refute arguments and theories and reasonings and every proud and lofty thing that sets itself up against the (true) knowledge of God; and we lead every thought and purpose away captive into the obedience of Christ, the Messiah, the Anointed One,

Gal. 3:13-14

Christ purchased our freedom (redeeming us) from the curse (doom) of the Law's (condemnation), by (Himself) becoming a curse for us, for it is written (in the Scriptures), Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree (is crucified); To the end that through (their receiving) Christ

Jesus, the blessing (promised) to Abraham might come upon the Gentiles, so that we through faith might (all) receive (the realization of) the promise of the (Holy) Spirit.

Gal. 3:29

And if you belong to Christ (are in Him, Who is Abraham's Seed), then you are Abraham's offspring and (spiritual) heirs according to promise.

Eph. 6:10-18

In conclusion, be strong in the Lord - be empowered through your union with Him; draw your strength from Him - that strength which His (boundless) might provides. Put on the whole armor - the armour of a heavy-armed soldier, which God supplies - that you may be able successfully to stand up against (all) the strategies and the deceits of the devil. For we are not wrestling with flesh and blood - contending only with physical opponents - but against the despotisms, against the powers, against (the master spirits who are) the world rulers of this present darkness, against the spirit forces of wickedness in the heavenly (supernatural) sphere. Therefore put on God's complete armor, that you may be able to resist and stand your ground on the evil day (of danger), and having done all (the crisis demands), to stand (firmly in your place). Stand therefore - hold your ground - having tightened the belt of truth around your loins, and having put on the breastplate of integrity and of moral rectitude and right standing with God; And having shod your feet in preparation (to face the enemy with the firm-footed stability, the promptness and the readiness produced by the good news) of the Gospel of peace. Lift up over all the (covering) shield of saving faith, upon which you can quench all the flaming missiles of the wicked (one). And take the helmet of salvation and the sword the Spirit wields, which is the Word of God. Pray at all times - on every occasion, in every season - in the Spirit, with all (manner of) prayer and entreaty. To that end keep alert and watch with strong purpose and perseverance, interceding in behalf of all the saints (God's consecrated people).

Phil. 2:13

(Not in your own strength) or it is God Who is all the while effectually at work in you --energizing and creating in you the power and desire --both to will and to work for His good pleasure and satisfaction and delight.

Healing Scriptures (Amplified Bible)

Phil. 4:6-7

Do not fret or have any anxiety about anything, but in every circumstance and in everything by prayer and petition (definite requests) with thanksgiving continue to make your wants known to God. And God's peace (be yours, that tranquil state of a soul assured of its salvation through Christ, and so fearing nothing from God and content with its earthly lot of whatever sort that is, that peace) which transcends all understanding, shall garrison and mount guard over your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.

II Tim. 1:7

For God did not give us a spirit of timidity--of cowardice, of craven and cringing and fawning fear--but (He has given us a spirit) of power and of love and of calm and well-balanced mind and discipline and self-control.

Heb. 10:35-36

Do not, therefore, fling away your fearless confidence, for it carries a great and glorious compensation of reward. For you have need of steadfast patience and endurance, so that you may perform and fully accomplish the will of God, and thus receive and carry away (and enjoy to the full) what is promised.

Heb. 11:11

Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the title-deed) of the things (we) hope for, being the proof of things (we) do not see and the conviction of their reality--faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses.

Heb. 13:8

Jesus Christ, the Messiah, (is always) the same, yesterday, today, (yes,) and forever--to the ages.

Jam. 5:14-16

Is any one among you sick? He should call in the church elders--the spiritual guides. And they should pray over him, anointing him with oil in the Lord's name. And the prayer (that is) of faith will save him that is sick, and the Lord will restore him; and if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. Confess to one another therefore your faults--your slips, your false steps, your offenses, your sins; and pray (also) for one another, that you may be healed and restored--to a spiritual tone of mind and heart. The earnest (heartfelt, continued) prayer of a

righteous man makes tremendous power available--dynamic in its working.

I Pet. 2:24

He personally bore our sins in His (own) body to the tree (as to an altar and offered Himself on it), that we might die (cease to exist) to sin and live to righteousness. By His wounds you have been healed.

I John 5:14-15

And this is the confidence - the assurance, the (privilege of) boldness - which we have in Him: (we are sure) that if we ask anything (make any request) according to His will (in agreement with His own plan) He listens to and hears us. And if (since) we (positively) know that He listens to us in whatever we ask, we also know (with settled and absolute knowledge) that we have (granted us as our present possessions) the requests made of Him.

III John 2

Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in every way and (that your body) may keep well, even as (I know) your soul keeps well and prospers.

Rev. 12:11

And they have overcome (conquered) him by the utterance of their testimony, for they did not love and cling to life even when faced with death - holding their lives cheap till they had to die (for their witnessing).
