

Living in the Supernatural!

Joh 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and **greater works** than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

Was Jesus supernatural - absolutely

The supernatural world is more real than the one we are in right now.

This world will pass away – God's world will not.

We serve a King who has a kingdom, of which we are subjects under the King. King Jesus. The King has made us Ambassadors of the Kingdom of God and placed us in authority here on the earth to carry out Kingdom business.

Jesus gave us commandment to do the supernatural

Mat 10:8 Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: **freely ye have received, freely give.**

Mar 16:15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

These things should be Everyday common occurrences and should be a normal part of our lives.

Some examples:

Jesus turns water into wine – John 2:7-10

Jesus speaks to the storm and says peace be still. – Mark 4:39

Jesus walks on the water - Matt 14:25

Jesus raises the dead – Luke 7:15

Jesus casts out demons with his word. – Mark 9:25

Jesus heals all the sick with a touch of his clothes - Matt 14:36

Paul's shadow heals people – Acts 5:15

Philip baptized the Eunuch and was translated over 100 miles away. - Acts 8:39

Most of us are not comfortable with those things outside what we call normal. As Christians everything above and much more is the NORM!

What is the supernatural. (all those things which we cannot explain from Gen – Rev.

I believe the supernatural is when God puts His super on your natural.

But more than that we must get it in our minds, our wills, our hearts, our words, our lives we are as much supernatural as God is.

The supernatural is the world that God lives in. There is no time or distance in His world.

We have access to that world – We are part of that world –

We have authority in both worlds. As it is in heaven let it be on the earth.

What you bind on earth is bound in heaven.

We have to change our attitudes, our mindsets, our hearts towards the supernatural – we all want to see people healed, but we do not see ourselves doing the healing.

Joh 12:46 I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not **abide** in darkness.

Joh 15:4 **Abide** in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it **abide** in the vine; no more can ye, except ye **abide** in me.

Joh 15:7 If ye **abide** in me, and my words **abide** in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it

shall be done unto you.

How do we live in that arena, when we have to live in a natural, dark, troublesome world?

Turn to Psa 91

The first term we come in contact with that will give us clear, precise instructions and method for living in the supernatural is, he that **ABIDES** *under the shadow of the most high*.

Abiding means that is where I live, I don't relocate every other attack, situation or problem. I live under the shadow of the almighty.

- *When we think like God we are in the supernatural*
- *When we act like God we are in the supernatural*
- *When we have faith like God we are in the supernatural – Faith is a supernatural force*
- *When we pray for people like God we are in the supernatural.*
- *When we talk like God we are in the supernatural*

Jesus paid the price – Everything that has been promised will come to pass.

Eph 1:17 That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the **spirit of wisdom and revelation** in the **knowledge of him**:

Eph 1:18 The **eyes of your understanding being enlightened**; that **ye may know** what is the **hope** of his calling, and what **the riches of the glory** of his inheritance in the saints,

Eph 1:19 And **what is the exceeding greatness** of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the **working of his mighty power**,

The power is flowing, working, operating, all we have to let it out.

Our overcoming victory lies in our abiding in the supernatural of God.

The supernatural is as close as the presence of the Lord, as close as the anointing that abides within you.

We are full of the supernatural power of God. Why do we shun from it. Why are we sometimes uncomfortable with it?

A last story –

The demonic of the Gaderines -

We know the story but the saddest part is this verse:

Luk 8:35 Then they went out to see what was done; and came to Jesus, and found the man, out of whom the devils were departed, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.

Fear is our greatest enemy – because it attacks our faith in God, or our faith in what God is doing.

Fear attacks our ability to comprehend the supernatural

And our ability to live and walk in it.
