

## **Scripture Promises for Our Children**

Acts 16:31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.

Roma 11:29 For the gifts and calling of God [are] without repentance.

Isai 49:24,25 Shall the prey be taken from the mighty, or the lawful captive delivered? But thus saith the LORD, Even the captives of the mighty shall be taken away, and the prey of the terrible shall be delivered: for I will contend with him that contendeth with thee, and I will save thy children.

Isai 54:13 And all thy children [shall be] taught of the LORD; and great [shall be] the peace of thy children.

Isai 54:17 No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue [that] shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This [is] the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness [is] of me, saith the LORD.

Phil 1:6 Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform [it] until the day of Jesus Christ:

Psal 91:3 Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, [and] from the noisome pestilence.

Psal 91:7 A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; [but] it shall not come nigh thee.

Psal 91:10-12 There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling. For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways. They shall bear thee up in [their] hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone.

Lame 3:22 [It is of] the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not.

Lame 3:23 [They are] new every morning: great [is] thy faithfulness.

Prov 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

Jere 31:16 Thus saith the LORD; Refrain thy voice from weeping, and thine eyes from tears: for thy work shall be rewarded, saith the LORD; and they shall come again from the land of the enemy.

Jere 31:17 And there is hope in thine end, saith the LORD, that thy children shall come again to their own border.

Zech. 10:8 (Amp) I will hiss for them (as the keeper does for his bees) and gather them in, for I have redeemed them, and they shall increase again as they have increased before (in Egypt).

1Joh 4:4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

1Cor 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.

Psal 55:9 Destroy, O Lord, [and] divide their tongues: for I have seen violence and strife in the city.

Jere 29:11-14 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end. Then shall ye call upon me, and ye shall go and pray unto me, and I will hearken unto you. And ye shall seek me, and find [me], when ye shall search for me with all your heart. And I will be found of you, saith the LORD: and I will turn away your captivity, and I will gather you from all the nations, and from all the places whither I have driven you, saith the LORD; and I will bring you again into the place whence I caused you to be carried away captive.

Jere 30:10 Therefore fear thou not, O my servant Jacob, saith the LORD; neither be dismayed, O Israel: for, lo, I will save thee from afar, and thy seed from the land of their captivity; and Jacob shall return, and shall be in rest, and be quiet, and none shall make [him] afraid.
