### I. WHO ARE YOU, IN CHRIST?

- a. **unique** (look like) (be like) (Heb. 4:12 - we are 3 parts)  
(Gen. 1:26) *And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness; and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.*  
(Psa. 139:14) *I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made: marvelous are thy works; and that my soul knoweth right well.*
- b. **called**  
(Isa. 43:1:1) *But now thus saith the LORD that created thee, O Jacob, and he that formed thee, O Israel, Fear not: for I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name; thou art mine.*  
(Isa. 43:1:7) *Even every one that is called by my name: for I have created him for my glory, I have formed him; yea, I have made him.*  
(Rom. 1:6,7) *Among whom are ye also the called of Jesus Christ: To all that be in Rome, beloved of God, called to be saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ.*  
(Rom. 8:28-31) *And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose. For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.*  
(I Cor. 1:2) *Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours:*  
(I Cor. 1:9) *God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord.*  
(I Cor. 1:24) *But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God.*  
(I Cor. 7:20) *Let every man abide in the same calling wherein he was called.*  
(I Cor. 7:24) *Brethren, let every man, wherein he is called, therein abide with God.*  
(Rom 11:29) *For the gifts and calling of God are without repentance.*
- c. **saved** (the Greek word is "sozo") (Isa. 53:4,5 and Isa. 61:1-3) It is finished (John 19:30 – II Pet. 1:3 all things) – (Salvation is: deliverance, freedom, healing, blessings, prosperity, peace, joy, fulfillment, and eternal life.) sin: to miss the mark, transgression: rebellion against rightful authority, Iniquity: being wicked, perverted – (Heb. 10:16,17 – Isa. 43:25 – Jer. 31:34)
- d. **new man**  
(Eph. 4:22-24) *That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; (see Jer. 17:9) And be renewed in the spirit of your mind; And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.*
- e. **new creation**  
(II Cor. 5:17) *Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. (Old things: see Phil. 3:13,14)*  
(Eph. 1:4) *According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love;*  
(Eph 1:5) *Having predestinated us into the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will;*  
(Eph. 1:6) *To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved.*  
(Eph. 1:7) *In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;*  
(Eph 1:13) *In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in who also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise,*

## II. YOUR IDENTITY

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- Identity = Name, character, personality, make-up, nature, qualities, traits, temperament (Prov.22:1 – Eccl.:12)
- Identify = Distinguish, know, perceive, recognize, relate, associate.
- a. **secure** = free from anxiety (fear), free from cares - (insecure = apprehensive, hesitant, timid, uncertain, unstable, defenseless, indecisive. You will be free from having someone or something try to mold you into something other than what God has for you to be.)
- b. **stable** = Not easily moved, firm, steady, reliable, dependable, steadfast.  
(James 1:8) *A double-minded man is unstable in all his ways.*
- c. **confident** (In Christ)  
(Phil 1:6) *Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ:*  
(Eph. 3:12) *In whom we have boldness and access with confidence by the faith of him.*
- d. **free from fear of man** ("fear not" found in 63 verses in the bible)  
Fear = A feeling of anxiety and agitation caused danger, evil, pain dread, terror, etc.  
(Pro. 29:25) *The fear of man bringeth a snare: but whoso putteth his trust in the Lord shall be safe.*  
(II Tim. 1:7) *For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind. (fear is also timidity) - you can also be intimidated - intimidation: easily frightened, no confidence, hesitant, controlled by others)*  
(John 8:36) *If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.*  
(Matt 10:28) *And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.*  
(Matt 10:29-32) *Are not two sparrows sold for a farthing? and one of them shall not fall on the ground without your Father. But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Fear ye not therefore, ye are of more value than many sparrows. Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven.*  
(Rom. 8:15) *For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.*  
(Rom. 8:16) *The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:*  
(Rom. 8:31) *What shall we then say to these things? If God [be] for us, who [can be] against us?*  
I (John 4:18) *There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love. (unconditional) (Rom. 13:10)*
- e. **established** make stable, set fast, fix, to render constant, confirm  
(Col. 1:11-14) *Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness; Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated [us] into the kingdom of his dear Son: In whom we have redemption through his blood, [even] the forgiveness of sins:*  
(Eph. 3:16-19) *That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man; That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, May be able to comprehend with all the saints what [is] the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fullness of God.*
- f. **unmovable**  
(1Cor 15:58) *Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye steadfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye now that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.*
- g. **spiritual** (not weird, not spooky, not prideful, nor arrogant) (see Gal. 6:1-11)  
(1Pet 2:5) *Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ*
- h. **relatable** (Jesus was the most spiritual person ever, he was also the most relatable, if you are not relatable you are not spiritual)

## II. YOUR IDENTITY (cont'd)

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(Heb. 4:14-16) Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast [our] profession. For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as [we are, yet] without sin. Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need. (Run to God when you mess up)      Infirmities = weaknesses

## III. WHAT DID GOD SAY?

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- a. **the word** (final authority) (we make the choice - see Deut. 30:19)  
(Psa 119:89) Forever, O Lord, thy word is settled in heaven. (John 1:1,14)  
(Isa 40:8) The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: but the word of our God shall stand forever.  
(Isa. 55:11) So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it. (note: Foundation: see Luke 6:44-49, Eph. 2:20)
- b. **faith** Not faith in faith, but faith in God, Faith is belief put into action  
(Rom. 1:17) For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.  
(II Cor. 5:7) (For we walk by faith, not by sight:)  
(Heb. 11:6) But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.  
(James 2:17) Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone. (not just believeing for the demons believe - see Jam. 2:19,20) (the opposite of faith is fear, False Evidence Appearing Real. Lies from the devil to keep you out of faith. see John 8:44) - (Heb. 11:1 – FAITH IS NOW!!)
- c. **trust** A firm belief in the honesty, integrity, of another person, thing - (rooted in the word "stand")  
(Jer. 1:12) Then said the Lord unto me, Thou hast well seen: for I will hasten my word to perform it.  
(Rom. 4:21) And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.  
(I Thes. 5:24) Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it. (This is a covenant, a blood covenant, it is final)
- d. **obey**  
Obey = To carry out instructions or orders, to submit to the control of (Authority). . . (root : to hear, understand & do)  
(I Sam. 15:22) And Samuel said, Hath the Lord (as great) delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the Lord? Behold, to obey (is) better than sacrifice, (and) to hearken than the fat of rams.  
(Matt. 7:21) Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father in heaven.  
(Acts 5:29) Then Peter and the (other) apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men. (think about some examples where you might have to do this)

## IV. WHAT AM I DOING HERE?

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- a. **rule** have dominion - (dominion = Rule or power to rule, ownership)  
(Gen. 1:26) And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.
- b. **purpose** a plan, a resolve, an intention to do, to complete (Acts 26:16 – Something one intends to do, complete, with an end in view) – (Jer. 29:11)  
(II Tim. 1:9) Who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began,  
(Rom. 8:28) And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.
- c. **vision** To perceive something not actually visible – (to envision – a part of hope – Hab. 2:1)  
(Pro. 29:18) Where there is no vision the people perish: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he.  
(we need daily vision of what God wants us to do)

## V. WHAT AM I DOING HERE? (cont'd.)

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### d. make disciples not converts

(Matt. 28:19) *Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:*

(Mark 16:15) *And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.*

(Acts 1:8) *But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.*

### e. it's your job!

(Eph. 4:1-3) *Therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called. With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love; Endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. - (Acts 1:8)*

## VI. WHAT DO I DO?

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### a. Deal with Your Mind

#### 1. strongholds, imaginations and thoughts

(II Cor. 10:4) *For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strongholds; Casting down imaginations, (our thoughts) and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;*

#### 2. that which stays in the mind will happen in time! (garbage in, garbage out)

(Isa. 26:3) *Thou wilt keep [him] in perfect peace, [whose] mind [is] stayed [on thee]: because he trusteth in thee*

(Prov. 23:7a) *For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he: (see Gal. 6:7 - sowing and reaping)*

#### 3. renew your mind

(Rom. 12:2) *And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. (see I Cor. 2:16 - we have the mind of Christ)*

#### 4. fully persuaded – (Stop doubt, unbelief – Col. 2:8 – Titus 1:14 – I John 2:15)

Rom. 4:20,21 *He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.*

#### 5. opinions

(limp)

(I Kings 18:21) *And Elijah came unto all the people, and said, How long halt ye between two opinions? if the Lord be God, follow him: but Baal, then follow him. And the people answered him not a word. - (look back to Rom. 12:2)*

#### 6. double minded – (to waver, Don't give it a second thought – Matt. 6:31)

(James 1:8) *A double minded man is unstable in all his ways.*

### b. Deal with Your words

#### 1. life and death

(Prov. 18:20,21) *A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth; and with the increase of his lips shall he be filled. Death and life are in the power of the tongue; and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof. (Mark 11:24 – Jam. 3:2,5-6,8-12 – Rom. 10:9,10 – John 7:38 - Take heed what you hear – Luke 4:4 – Jam 1:19)*

#### 2. from the heart

(Matt. 12:34) *O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh. (being under pressure reveals what's in the heart)*

(Matt. 15:8) *This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with [their] lips; but their heart is far from me.*

#### 3. justified or condemned

(Matt. 12:37) *For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned. (Prov. 6:2 – Psa. 31:20 – Psa 19:14, Psa 141:3)( the power of words and unity – Gen. 11:1-9 tower of Babel)*

## VII. WHAT DO I DO? (con'td.)

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### a. Deal with Your actions

#### 1. faith without works is dead

(Jam. 2:17) Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone.

#### 2. are you believing, presuming, or wishing

Faith = Unquestioning belief that does not require proof or evidence.

(Rom10:17) *So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.*

(Heb. 11:1) *Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.*

Belief = To take as true, real, trust in, have confidence in.

Presume = To take upon one's self without permission or authority, take for granted. - (Rom 14:23 – Mark 12:24)

(Deut. 18:20) *But the prophet, which shall presume to speak a word in my name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or that shall speak in the name of other gods, even that prophet shall die.- (Psa. 19:13 – Matt. 12:31)*

(II Pet. 2:10) *But chiefly them that walk after the flesh in the lust of uncleanness, and despise government, Presumptuous are they, self-willed, they are not afraid to speak evil of dignities.*

Wish = A longing for, desire, want - (has a root to "strive for")

#### 3. responding or reacting

We must respond to person or circumstance with God's word, and not react from our understanding, abilities or emotions.

### d. Take Your stand – (or another way to see it – make your decision)

1. standing To take, maintain, or be in a specified position, attitude, or course. To remain unchanged, intact, effective, or valid.(see Jam. 4:7,8 (two fold: submit and resist) and I Pet. 5:6-9)

(Eph. 6:11-18) *Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness: (the mask is not part of the armor)*

#### 2. strength and ability

(Phil 4:13) *I can do all things through Christ which strengtheth me. (Eph. 3:20 – II Cor. 9:8 – II Time 1:12)*

3. boldness Boldness =Might, strength, to be strong, freedom to speak with no reservation, free and fearless confidence (boldness comes by righteousness, relationship, identity, confidence, faith and obedience – care free I Pet. 5:7 – boldness takes risks, no fear

(I John 4:4) *Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.*

(Heb. 10:19) *Having therefore, bretheren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus.*

(Phil. 1:20) *According to my earnest expectation and my hope, that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but that with all boldness, as always, so now also Christ shall be magnified in my body, whether it be by life, or by death.*

(Acts 4:13,31) *Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marveled; and they took knowledge of them, that they had been with Jesus. (speaks of relationship) (Prov. 28:1 – bold as a lion)*

4. confidence (also boldness) - Confidence = Firm trust, belief, reliance

(Pro. 3:26) *For the Lord shall be they confidence, and shall keep they foot from being taken.*

(Pro. 14:26) *In the fear of the Lord is strong confidence: and his children shall have a place of refuge.*

(Heb. 10:35) *Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompense of reward.*  
Col. 1:9-14 and II Pet. 1:3-10

### **The building of the temple**

Stones prepared in the quarries underneath the city of huge dimension were gradually placed on the massive walls, and closely fitted together without any mortar between, till the whole structure was completed. No sound of hammer or axe or any tool was heard as the structure arose. "Like some tall palm the noiseless fabric sprang" The building was 60 cubits long, 20 cubits wide, and 30 cubits high. 90 feet long, 30 feet wide and 45 feet high. The engineers of the Palestine Exploration Fund, in their explorations around the temple area, discovered what is believed to have been the "chief corner stone" of the temple, "the most interesting stone in the world." It lies at the bottom of the southeastern angle, and is 3 feet 8 inches high by 14 feet long. It rests on the solid rock at a depth of 79 feet 3 inches below the present surface.

**Build upon the foundation.** They have been built into the temple of the Lord. The word of God, declared by apostles and prophets, is the foundation of their faith. **Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner (stone).** The corner stone was a stone of double size at the corner, which became a part of both walls and lined them together. So he had joined the Jews and Gentiles in the building. He is the foundation stone on which the building rests, and the stone of union.

Note also that if you use a perfectly square stone as the beginning place of measurement for a building all alignments off that stone will produce perfectly square walls etc. This is why we must build everything lined up with Jesus who is our corner stone.

**Blaspheme:** Slander, detraction, speech injurious to another's good name – impious or reproachful speech injurious to divine majesty. **Root:** speaking evil, railing, abusive

**Presumptuous:** arrogant, proud, insolent, to boil, seethe, act proudly

Psa. 19:13 (sins with an uplifted hand) – take for granted – **root:** to consume

**React:** to act in return, reciprocate, to act because of a stimulus, influence, event (no control.)

**Respond:** to answer, reply, to have a positive or favorable reaction (under control)
